The P7 teachers have posted on Seesaw to indicate to parents how they can enter their child for the exam, if they choose. The closing date is Fri 22^{nd} September.


Application for Free School Meals.

A lot of the school funds that we receive from DE is based on the percentage of pupils we have in receipt of Free School Meals. Our percentage has dropped and funding has been reduced as a result of this. I encourage all families who might be eligible to apply, even if their child chooses to take packed lunches. Road safety message

- Dropping your child off in the correct zone. NB pupils should never be walking in between parked cars.

Traffic management

We are wading through a huge volume of applications for parking permits. Our school cannot accommodate the vast number asking to enter and wait in school at dismissal time.

Therefore, applications from parents of P4-P7 pupils will not be facilitated, (Unless the P4-P7 pupils holds his/her own blue badge).

P4-P7 children are led to the school gates by the class teacher and therefore the person collecting will have to collect from outside the school.

Parents have worked with me so nicely in the mornings this week, especially when I have pointed out that we operate a drop off only zone- thank you to every parent I approached who responded to my request so graciously. The result is that the morning traffic is operating quite smoothly.

Collection time however has been a different matter as there has been so much congestion that the buses and taxis for our pupils in the ECPD unit were significantly delayed. This cannot happen.

The 2pm gate will be tightly managed from Monday on and the only people who will be given entrance will be those to whom a parking permit has been issued.

In an ideal world our school would have been built with sufficient parking for our 50 + staff and 500+ families however that is not the case and therefore we have to manage the situation with courtesy and common sense.
