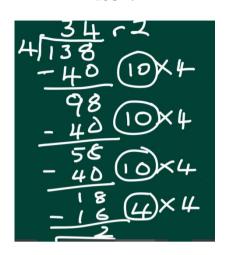

This is the same as asking how many 4s in 138?

I know that $10 \times 4 = 40$.

138-40= 98

I know that $10 \times 4 = 40$.

98-40=58

I know that $10 \times 4 = 40$.

58-40=18

I know that $4\times4=16$.

18-16=2

10 sets of 4 add 10 sets of 4 add 10 sets of 4 add 4 sets of 4 equals 34 sets of 4 with 2 left over. This is the same as saying

138÷4=34 remainder 2. (34r2)
