Dear Parents,

I hope that you found the children refreshed this week after their break from the screens over mid-term. I know that the staff certainly felt the need for and enjoyed that same screen break.

I draw your attention to the following:

1. Return to school update:

You will be aware from the media that Nursery and P1-P3 pupils will return to school on Monday 8th March. I had held off until today before contacting you about this as I wanted to see if there would be changes announced yesterday, at this point it appears that there will not.

Therefore, we look forward to having the younger members of our school back with us for a period of face to face teaching. Then on the week commencing 22nd they will revert to 'Learning From Home' until the Easter holidays.

We plan to have school running as it had been in term 1 for Nursery and P1-P3 pupils when they return. That means that:

- Early morning supervision will be in place from 8.15
- School meals will be available as required
- School uniform/tracksuit will continue to be worn on alternative days
- No schoolbag arrangement will remain in place
- Requirements for parents to wear masks on school grounds and to observe social distancing will remain.
- Dismissal times from classroom doors will be as they were
