1. Say the whole sum and estimate the answer by rounding.

423 is between 400 and 500 - it is closer to 400 because 23 is less than the halfway mark of 50.354 is between 300 and 400 - it is closer to 400 because the 54 is more than the halfway mark of 50.400 and 400 is 800 so my answer is approximately 800.
2. Start with the units' column. 3 units add 4 units equals 7 units. Record.
3. Next I look at the tens column. 2 tens add 5 tens equals 7 tens. Record.
4. Now go to the hundreds column. 4 hundreds add 3 hundreds equals 7 hundreds. Record.
5. Say 423 add 354 equals 777. Draw a line under your answer and compare it to your estimate.
