2. 5 units take away 2 units equals 3 units
3. 7 tens take away 3 tens is 4 tens.
4. 5 hundreds take away 4 hundreds is 1 hundred.
5. Say your answer as one hundred and forty three, drawing a line underneath.
6. Compare your estimate with the actual answer. Was it approximately 200?
