

March Message: World Book Day

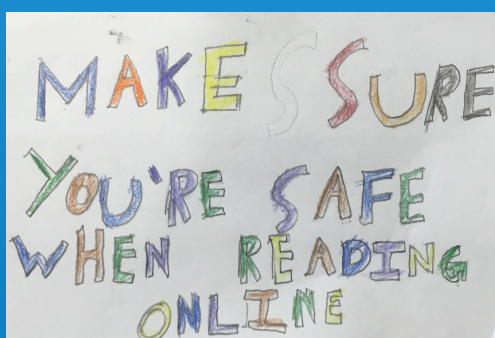
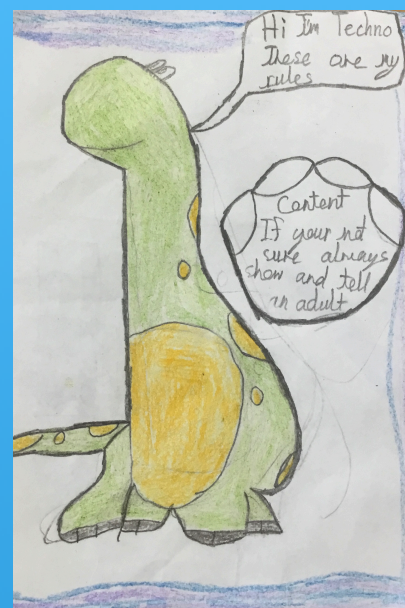
World Book Day is celebrated in March. It may be really fun and exciting but you must stay safe if you are reading online or if you're going to the library. We will show you how to keep safe when you are reading online.

Here is a list of things you shouldn't do:

- Don't borrow books that look threatening on the internet.
- Don't buy books with money without asking an adult for permission.
- Don't borrow / buy books that strangers recommend unless you recognise the book.
- Only read books that you are old enough to read.
- Never borrow random books without telling an adult.

And here is a list of things you should do:

- Borrow books that look safe.
- You should borrow books that an adult or teacher recommends.
- Read books from the authors you know.
- Use reading apps that you recognise.
- Always read books age appropriate for you.



Now make sure you follow these rules and also remember to ask your parents or another sensible relative if there is something that you are unsure of.
